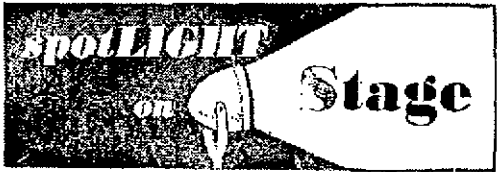

In addition to keeping a close liaison with paralleling theater activities and problems in other parts of the nation, Texas COMPO carried out regional assignments for NATO and National COMPO to implement industry programs in Texas.

The decision to change the name of Texas COMPO, which in the past served as a regional affiliate for the 10,000-member National Association of Theater Owners, was made on the 18th anniversary of the founding of the state organization.

When Texas COMPO was conceived in July, 1951, by two giants in the amusement world, R. J. O'Donnell and Colonel H. A. Cole, it marked one of the first regional mergers of Theater Owners of America and Allied States Association and the first big assignment was to conduct the mammoth "Movietime in Texas" campaign.

Among its many accomplishments, Texas COMPO established the first complete regional voluntary film classification system which eventually served as a model for the national rating plan now accepted and used by practically every motion picture exhibitor in the nation.

Taylor Theater Offer Is Varied

Five different categories of a Dallas Theater Center Production of the classic 18th Century style comedy of manners, "She Stoops to Conquer," a Peter Ustinov comedy or a famous French farce will be staged as one of the winter productions, and a unique "happening" in May will take the audience progressively to a 11 three playing areas on the different levels of the theater.

All five kinds of season memberships also offer a number of other advantages including advance notification of productions, early reservation privileges, and attendance at special events during the year.

Books of season scrip purchased under the different membership plans offer flexible use of \$21 worth of scrip for any production of the theater. Season memberships include: Theater Sponsors — sponsorships at \$100 entitle the holder to a tax deduction of \$70, two books of scrip, and listing on the program at each performance.

Memberships in all categories (except the student subscriptions) may be purchased now at the theater box office or through the theater's Women's Committee.

The upcoming Fourth Season will bring a richly varied bill of fare to the handsome arcaded structure on Trinity Hill. A tentative production scheduled announced last week is designed to explore the wide range of possibilities in good theater — the innovative and the traditional, the light-hearted and the provocative.
